GRAMMY-NOMINATED ELECTRO-HOP GROUP “LMFAO”
ADDED TO RFK STADIUM’S SHAMROCKFEST LINEUP

ALERT: RFK Stadium Main Gates to open at Noon instead of 1 p.m.

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The [Washington Convention and Sports Authority](#) (WCSA) and [ShamrockFest](#) announced today that electro-hop group [LMFAO](#) will perform at the 10th annual ShamrockFest, to be held on the RFK Stadium festival grounds starting at 1 p.m. on Saturday, March 13. LMFAO will begin their set promptly at 1 p.m.

With 10 stages and over 40 incredible live bands and DJs, ShamrockFest is regarded as one of the most popular St. Paddy’s Day parties in America. The main gates to the RFK Stadium festival grounds will now open at noon. The VIP area will open at 1 p.m. The day-long, music fest is scheduled to end at 9 p.m.

“In order to ensure that attendees have access to the early musical performances, we decided the best course of action was to open the RFK Stadium main gates at noon,” explained Erik A. Moses, managing director of the WCSA Sports, Entertainment and Special Events Division.

LMFAO, a Grammy-nominated group from Los Angeles, are known for their lively performances and dance-friendly tunes. The duo enjoyed *Billboard* Hot 100 hits - “**La La La**” and “**Shots**” featuring Lil Jon - from their 2009 debut album “**Party Rock**,” and released their newest single titled “**Make U Mine**” this January.

The addition of LMFAO further illustrates the wide-range of music to be showcased at ShamrockFest throughout the day. The DJ Zone features hit tunes while dozens of simultaneous live performances in the massive festival area will feature rock, reggae, folk, Irish, blues, club, alternative and hip-hop music. The concert and DJ areas are located in RFK Stadium Lot 7.

LMFAO joins a talented lineup that includes [The Roots](#) and [Train](#) in their festival debuts, and popular favorites [Mr. Greengenes](#) and [Carbon Leaf](#). Other bands include Schythian, Seven Nations, Bare Knuckle Boxers, Black 47, Ice Wagon Flu, The Rovers, White Ford Bronco and DJs Chris Styles, Kwest and Pat Premier.
